Jill started curling at the age of ten and by seventeen had won her first provincial championship. She has added numerous other titles to her accomplishments including four Canadian Scotties Tournament of Hearts National Championships (most recent in 2010) and the 2008 World Women's Championship. Her team, skipped by Jennifer Jones out of Winnipeg, plans to make another run toward the Olympics in 2014 in Russia. Through Jill's success in curling, there have been many challenges as well, but her most difficult one came in 2006 when she trekked for 27 days to reach the Base Camp at Mt. Everest.
