### Waste Collection by Penner Waste 331-4285

Waste must be in closed containers or bags and **weigh no more than 40 lb (18kg) each. Liquids are NOT allowed.**

Waste may not be left at the curbside for more than 12 hours.

### Water Conservation - Every Drop Helps

For yard watering, the odd and even system is in effect. Even numbered houses may only water on even numbered calendar days and odd on odd.

### Regional Landfill Site - S.W.A.M.P. at 325-2216

Located northeast of Winkler. All loads must be tied or covered. No liquid, hazardous waste, or vehicles allowed.

### Snow Removal Parking Ban

Parking on Winkler streets is not allowed when snow removal is required, day or night. Offenders may be ticketed and/or towed away. For more information see website: [www.winklerpolice.ca](http://www.winklerpolice.ca)

### Open Fires

Must be contained and supervised and between 8:00 am and 11:00 pm. Burning of garbage and yard waste is prohibited.

### Lawn Mowing – Weed Control

In the case of uncared-for lots, the City may have grass cut, weeds sprayed, garbage cleaned up and soil leveled without notification and billed to the property owner. Please be responsible.

### Sump Pumps

No discharge to streets in freezing weather.

### Dog/Cat Droppings

You must clean up after your animals.

### Animal Control

Call 362-4193 for concerns with wild or domestic animals.

### Street Light Not Working?

### Garages and Storage

Sea Containers (metal storage containers) and Tent Garages are not allowed in residential neighborhoods.

### CURBSIDE BLUE BOX

Guidelines for Blue Box materials: Use bags to SEPARATE: Food Cans: rinsed, flattened.

- Lids from glass jars: removed from jars.

SEPARATE: - Aluminum Drink Cans: rinsed and squashed


SEPARATE: - Plastic Drink Bottles & Plastic Containers: rinsed (#1, 2, 4, 5, 7 plastics)


SEPARATE: - Glass Bottles and Jars: washed, unbroken, lids removed or Drop off at GATEWAY RESOURCES, 1582 PEMBINA AVE.

\* PLACE GLASS in the recycling trailer parked at GATEWAY RESOURCES. NO windows, glass furniture, light bulbs, ceramics, etc.

### BLUE BAGS

**PAPER MUST BE BAGGED**

 Please place all paper in blue bag; Newspaper, flyers, envelopes, magazines, catalogues, phone books, kraft, bond, computer paper, milk cartons-clean, dry, flattened, aseptic containers (juice boxes), cardboard.

 No: ~ Carbon Paper ~ Sugar Bags, etc. ~ Christmas Wrap  
~ Paper that has been wet or soiled,

\* No household waste, renovation or demolition waste shall be delivered to Gateway Resources. Clean Recyclables Only - No Exceptions

Please help us { \* Boxboard } Must be flattened.  
{ \* Cardboard (clean) } and bagged, boxed or tied.

### COMPOST

Collected at the curb April 1<sup>st</sup> - November 30<sup>th</sup> on YOUR WASTE PICKUP DAY or

Drop off at the compost site on George Street (follow the signs)

~ Use see-through garbage bags or Compostable

~ Keep under 40 lbs. (18 kg)

### USED OIL DEPOT: "ECO CENTRE"

Located at 345 - 1st Street, the used oil depot called an "ECO Centre" will be open on designated Saturdays from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm to receive Crankcase, Engine, and Gear Oils, as well as Hydraulic and Transmission Fluids, Oil Filters and used Oil Containers.

Maximum delivery is not to exceed 30 litres. Larger quantities can be accepted by special arrangement.



### USED COOKING OIL/FAT

Used household cooking oil will be received on the same days and location as used motor oil.

**DO NOT dispose of cooking oils or fat into kitchen sinks/drains.**
